Duties: HO PHYSICAL THERAPY seeks a PHYSICAL THERAPIST in Beverly Hills, California to:

Summary: Provide care to patients who have functional problems resulting from back and neck injuries; sprains, strains, and fractures; arthritis; amputations; neurological disorders, such as stroke or cerebral palsy; injuries related to work and sports; and other conditions.

Detailed job duties:

- Review and evaluate patients' conditions, medical history, medical records/charts and referrals/notes from doctors, surgeons, and other healthcare workers.
- Perform tests and measurements, observe standing and walking, listen to concerns and use other methods to diagnose patients' functions and movements.
- Interpret findings and develop programs for treatment plans to consistent with physicians' directions/orders.
- Develop individualized plans of care for patients, outlining the patients' goals and the expected outcomes of the plans.
- Help patients attain maximum physical strength and motor skills and accept and adjust to the limit effects of their disabilities.
- Use exercises, stretching maneuvers, hands-on therapy, and equipment to ease patients' pain; help them increase their mobility; increase their strength, endurance, coordination and range of motion; prevent further pain or injury, and facilitate health and wellness.
- Administer traction, massage, and other treatments including moist packs, ultraviolet and infrared lamps and ultrasound machines to improve patients' comfort and aid in recovery.
- Introduce/utilize stimuli to facilitate motor activity and learning.
- Instruct patients on activities of daily living and use of assistive devices.
- Evaluate and record patient progress, evaluate the effectiveness of treatment with other team members and modify plan of care, fine-tune therapeutic procedures and treatments and try new treatments as needed.
- Educate patients and their families about what to expect from the recovery process, and how best to cope with challenges throughout the process.
- Motivate and instruct patients, families and other caregivers to help patients through the treatment and convalescent period.
